This VbA Course is developed from a collective wisdom of many years of offering Living Values Education into the world, it is made possible today by previously unavailable technology in this delivery of Living Values Education training and implementation.

COURSE PARTICIPANTS

The VbA Course is currently offered free of charge, and designed to be inclusive and applicable to various individuals and groups. It is planned for use in teacher-training universities and colleges used by teachers in classrooms with young adult high school students, included in conferences, parents at home with children, or adapted for special interest groups such as police, prisons, or hospitals.

COURSE CONTENT

ALIVE Board members and ALIVE Associate and Focal Points internationally have contributed to this VbA Training Course content, providing 6-8 hours of values training materials, values educational awareness, teacher assistance, and values classroom materials offered with delivery techniques. Each values aspect covered is a self-standing assignment with built-in points earning questions that, when answered, demonstrate the participant's comprehension of the content. Personal Values Self-Assessment and Mind-Mapping training are also included to create self-reflective consideration. These all serve as evaluations toward participant LVE international certification.

REQUIRED TO COMPLETE FOR CERTIFICATION

- Registered Participants can access the Course with their Access key – **log in anytime from midnight** PST (Pacific Standard Time) **14th June** and thereafter anytime in the 21 days before the **Course closes 5th July 2026**.
- Participants will be eligible for Living Values Education International Certification subject to having achieved their required points and completed by 5th July 2026.
- In the event that insufficient points have been gained participants may elect to repeat by registering for next scheduled Course at no cost.

REGISTRATION

Registrations open 20th May 2026. Must be received the day before the **Course start date Sunday 14th June** after which the Registration closes and the Course begins.

AFTER EACH VALUES SESSION

Participants are invited to provide feedback through three, five questions. Answers may be as extensive as the participant chooses. These questions provide the opportunity to reflect on the session and demonstrate understanding of the material, each answer gains a point contributing to your final score. All questions must be answered.

SHOWCASING THE COURSE

At the beginning, a 'points-related' Mind Map of the participant's design is introduced, established, and added to progressively through the Course to capture the participant's visual experience based on what is gained from each session.

TAKEAWAY ASPECTS OF THE VBA

In addition to the three questions to be answered following each activity, points also come from to update their perspective and understanding through their visual Mind Map and also the personal Values assessment using the LVE 15-minute Values Self Reflection Check-In (Quiz) early on allowing participants to view a change in their values awareness.

LVE VBA ALUMNAE

Those participants who have completed all the sessions and have achieved certification are eligible to join this group with further opportunities for additional LVE Facilitator Training.
